We are searching for a motivated and independent postdoc researcher, who will join to several ongoing projects, analyze and interpret existing data, write scientific publications, as well as participate and lead future research proposals.

Candidate's profile and competences:

1. Who can apply?

PhD Degree must have been awarded after January 1, 2015.

Candidates must not have been previously beneficiary of a Sara Borrell grant.

2. Requirements:

Good record of publications in high impact journals: in the last 5 years, candidates must have a minimum of 4 publications in the first quartile/decile as lead author (first, last or corresponding author).

Research trajectory focused on at least one of the following areas:

- Environmental Epidemiology
- Human exposure to environmental factors
- Obesity-related disorders
- Subclinical markers of disease

- Good communication skills (English and/or Spanish)
- Experience in data analyses in biomedical research
- International research stays
- Previous participation in research projects
- General laboratory skills
